

EmVista Maintenance Station

EmVista Maintenance Station is a licensed Microsoft Windows desktop application used to inspect and maintain the EmVista Database. It includes facilities to program and test endpoint devices.

The EmVista Database is at the heart of EmVista. Because of EmVista's data-driven architecture, EmVista Database objects define all elements managed by EmVista applications, from endpoint and conference types to users and user interface characteristics.

EmVista Maintenance Station employs a one-page GUI with a Selection Pane containing icons for database objects and an Editor Pane that displays data pertinent to the currently selected item in the Selection Pane. Depending on a user's status, the fields displaying the data may be read-only or modifiable.

EmVista Maintenance Station is part of the EmVista Extended and Enterprise Editions suites but is also available as a standalone application for programming and maintaining endpoint devices. In conjunction with Emcom's Automatic SNMP Service for Endpoint Testing (ASSET), EmVista Maintenance Station controls the continuous testing of all endpoints defined in the EmVista Database.
